### Change Log

All positions have been manually verified against Orestar output of candidates. However, Orestar missed some candidates, such as HD8, and incorrectly output others, such as SD27  
To make future data input easier, SDs with no race this year have been removed.

#### *March 6 Changes*

New entrants have been added along with some corrections to previous data.  
New candidates in SDs 6, 7, 11, 17, 20, 24 fills out the roster and now no open seats in Senate  
HDs 7, 11 (multiple), 15, 22, 26, 41, 45, 51, 50, 36 entrants added

#### *March 7 Changes*

A Repub entered CD3. Now, all CDs have at least one candidate from each party  
12 total new entrants in House Districts: 9 Ds and 3 Rs  
New Ds in HD races: one each in 1, 19, 24, 26, 38, 45, and 59, and 3 in HD 11  
New Rs in HD races: 11 (2) and 43  
Only one addition to SDs: a new Repub in SD20, which already had a R in the race  
Still No R in HDs 28, 34, 41, 44, 45, 46, and 47  
No D in HDs 4, 6, 9, 17, 57, 58, and 60

#### *March 8 Changes*

No Republicans running in HDs 44, 45, 47 (all Multnomah County)  
No Democrats running in HDs 4 & 9 (SW Oregon), 17 Linn/Marion), 57 (Central OR), and 58 & 60 (E & SE Oregon)  
SD 4 ended with no Republican in the race against a well-established incumbent
